ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

If you are a family experiencing homelessness and you can affirm <u>ALL</u> of the following statements, you are encouraged to complete the following Hope House Family Navigation application:

 \Box I am a parent with dependent children in my custody.

□ I am homeless or am imminently going to become homeless.

□ I have been a resident of Albemarle County, Fluvanna County, Louisa County, Nelson County or the City of Charlottesville for the past <u>six months</u>.

□ I work at least part-time or am enrolled in a post-secondary educational program.

□ I possess the required legal documents to work in the United States.

□ I, any co-applicant, and any child/ren in my custody, are free from felony criminal convictions for any violence, assault, theft or destruction of property.

□ My children will be enrolled in school full time in the residential school district of my address and will attend school as required.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

- □ Single person.
- $\hfill\square$ No minor children in physical custody
- □ Not homeless or imminently going to become homeless
- $\hfill\square$ Do not meet residency requirement of six months in area
- □ Unemployed or unable to become employed (permanently disabled)
- □ Immigrant who cannot work legally in the United States
- □ Felony convictions for distribution of controlled substances, child endangerment, domestic or other acts of violence; assault, theft or destruction of property convictions.
- □ Registered sex offender
- □ Unable or unwilling to relocate to Hope House properties
- Unwilling to enroll children in residential school district associated with Hope House address. (Some exceptions if children being served through McKinney-Vento)
- Any person involved in a situation of domestic violence with another applicant
- Any person unable or unwilling to actively participate in classes or other activities associated with Hope House program placement
